Dear Resident:

I am pleased to announce that effective immediately the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will extend the Residential Parking Permit (RPP) program to the 1600 block of Park Road, NW.


DDOT is aware of the parking constraints for the residents in the 1600 block of Park Road due to the reconstruction project on Park Road, NW; therefore the Department is providing each household with Zone 1 RPP protection. Every resident that obtains an RPP sticker will be eligible to park in any legal curbside parking space anywhere in Ward 1. When the RPP restrictions go in effect, if you do not have the appropriate Zone 1 sticker, your vehicle will be subject to ticketing and possible towing. Please go to one of the following Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) locations and purchase an RPP sticker:

- 301 C Street, NW (Adjudication Services)
- 3220 Pennsylvania Avenue, SE (Penn Branch Service Center)
- 3222 M Street, NW (Georgetown Service Center)
- 95 M Street, SW (Southwest Service Center)
- 1233 Brentwood Road, NE (Brentwood Square Mall)

DMV performs parking permit services from 8:15 am to 4:00 pm at all abovementioned centers. The RPP sticker costs fifteen (\$15.00) dollars and the price is prorated based on when the sticker is purchased. You may also obtain an RPP sticker on-line.
